

Second Grade Year at a Glance

Math:

We will be busy learning all kinds of new concepts in math! We start with reviewing basic adding and subtracting then moving along to adding and subtracting two and three digit numbers. This will include carrying and borrowing from the tens and hundreds place. We will also be learning about measurement, fractions, money and telling time.

Reading:

In this subject we break down stories we read in class. We look at the setting, characters, plot, and problems of each story and go into great detail of each one. We also learn new genres. Other areas we look at are sequencing in stories, inferring and predicting, as well as, the purpose of a story. A few stories that are class favorites include the following: Click, Clack Moo, Teacher's Pet, and Diary of a Spider.

Language Arts/Writing

Second graders learn all kind of new things in this subject. We cover things like parts of speech, subjects and predicates, types of sentences and how to write stories. We also work on making our handwriting be the best it can be!

Science:

We touch on areas like space, matter, plants and weather. One fun thing we do is plant our own personal gardens and watch them grow! Second graders will also get to do research over their favorite animal and dive into different habitats.

Social studies:

Here we learn about our past and present ways of life. Second Graders also learn about maps and the oceans and continents. During Social Studies we do a state research project along with a famous person research project, including people like Sally Ride and Neil Armstrong. We travel back in time with the Native Americans and Christopher Columbus. Learning about the parts of our government and how to vote is fun too!
